- Ability to use equipment such as measuring devices, digital cameras, ladders, etc.
- Candidate must have an active estimating system (required by client), and have the ability to send electronic reports through the Internet.
- To handle any type of claims for BCSI, you will be required to take a drug test and go through our criminal background check process.
- Bilingual a plus but not required.
